- Analyze and provide input and feedback on regulatory policies to ensure the efficient and effective regulation of customs operations in line with Canadian law and international agreements.
- Review customs procedures to facilitate legitimate trade and border fluidity
- Serve as an advisory body to government agencies and policymakers on customs/trade-related issues
- Provide expertise and guidance on international trade agreements and border security policies.
